Dear Bruce;

We received the notice (which you told me about over the phone) which indicated a higher premium of \$2.47 each quarter for our insurance, and that the policy would be cancelled soon if payment would not be sent. This does not strike me as being fair, since we paid what you said the premium should be. It isn't the amount that's so important (although another \$10.00 per year might have influenced our decision for a local agent's insurance, had we have had the correct amount in the beginning) but it does seem that the policy should cover us for a while at least.

I would appreciate you writing and letting the brethren here know as to the reason for this mistake, as I went to bat for you and I can't very well present the reason, other than there was a mistake in your figuring, which should have been rechecked when our primary consideration was was the ~~premium~~ per year.

The past treasurer has been gone quite a lot (he is planning to move) so I don't know whether he has sent the extra amount in or not, but we appointed a new one to take his place and he'll see that the new amount is sent in when he learns about it.
