Last Herember, elliers were appointed and prespects are good that we can appoint deacons before long. The church is located (church building, that is) within the city limits of this small term (approx. 2000 population) and is in the precess of purchasing adjacent land for expansion. A new classrest addition was completed a couple of years ago and we are soon going to need more space, both in our classroom and auditorium aspect. We have a three bedroom home located adjacent to the church building which should accommodate your family, I believe.
