She hopes to get a teaching ich by this fall, but things are working out pretty close, time-wise, so I don't know whether she'll be able to do it or not. Our son starts to Abilene this fall for his last two years. He attended Michigan Christian College the first two years. He has a job now but has to work on the second shift, which he doesn't particular like. He does save more money that way, however. Hal
